What is Windssock?

It's the Weathervane Theatre's summer day camp for kids 7 to 17, now with all-day sessions for every ability!

Who is Windssock?

New friends, experienced staff, and theatre professionals – who all come together for an outstanding opportunity to discover new talents and sharpen skills.

Windssock Director Nate Gilbert, Weathervane Artistic Director Jacques Stewart, along with an experienced staff and volunteers from the Weathervane professional company will all be on hand for the total-immersion program.

Camper's come from all over the North Country – and beyond – with visiting families encouraged to enroll.

When and Where can you find Windssock?

WHEN? Camp begins in August:

Act I - two one-week sessions, Aug. 9-14 and 16-21, each with performance on the Saturday.

Act II - one two-week session, Aug. 9-21, with performance on Sat. 8-21

Act III - three weeks, Aug. 2-21, with performances Sat 8-14 & 21.

Where? Right at the Weathervane Theatre on Rte 3, Whitefield!

A professional summer theatre founded in 1966, the Weathervane is an award-winning, established leader in live performance for northern New Hampshire.

Play *IS* the thing - with Acts for every ability and interest.

Each Act builds experience and skills: a typical week for beginners includes:

Monday: Registration, Warmup, Getting-to-know-you and Theatre games, Weatherwane Tour, Windsock skills building, Introduction to Performance skills and creation

Tuesday: Warmup and Theatre games, Windsock skills building, Comedy Techniques, Lighting class, Song rehearsal, Dance rehearsal, Introduction to skit-writing and small-group work.

Wednesday: Warmup and Theatre games, Movement training, Mask-making, Costumes and/or Tie-dye, Full performance rehearsal

Thursday: Warmup and Theatre games, Movement training, Classes with Weatherwane Company Members, Painting or Art project, Full performance rehearsal

Friday: Warmup and Theatre games, Movement training, Final Rehearsal, Goodbye circle.

Saturday: Warmup 8:30am with Performance at 9:00am

Campers will bring their own lunch, and registrants will receive a list of helpful hints about appropriate clothing, insect repellent (we spend a lot of time outdoors!), and more.

ACT I – for young performers, age 7 (by July 1) through age 10

An introduction to theatre and movement, the one-week session (available in two 'scenes' of one week each) meets from 9 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday, and a Saturday morning performance on the Weatherwane Mainstage.

Camp t-shirt & 40+ hours of fun! **\$195**

ACT II – for returning or more experienced troupers, ages 10 through 13

The two-week session builds on skills learned in Act I in a two-week session. The longer day, 9 am to 5 pm, meets Monday through Friday for two weeks, with Saturday morning performance on the Weatherwane Mainstage at the session completion.

Camp t-shirt & 80 hours of fun! **\$275**

ACT III – advanced and leadership skills, ages 13 to 17

Three-week, all inclusive experience for older or returning campers explores creatively all aspects of theatre and performance. First week Monday-Friday from 10 am to 4 pm is followed by two weeks from 9 am to 5 pm; and performance on both Saturdays with Act I and Act II.

Camp t-shirt & 3 weeks of fun! **\$350**

How can I enroll?

Registration form included: complete and return early, as classes fill up fast! Each camper receives a free Windsock tee-shirt; and of course, families and friends are all welcome at the free Windsock Saturday performances.

What else do I need to know?
